

ATTENDANCE AT OTHER THAN HOME SCHOOL

A: The Board can by motion authorize a student to attend a school other than the home school if he (she) has been recommended by the School and Division Administration for a program not offered in the home school. If such authorization is given, transportation will be provided.

B: The Board can by motion authorize students to attend a school other than the home school upon presentation of a written request from the parents or guardians. Such authorization will either: (a) provide transportation from the home to the alternate school, or (b) require the family to meet an existing transportation route.

Authorization to attend an alternate school will remain in force until: (a) the youngest student has completed the highest grade in that school, (b) the family moves to a different location, (c) the Board rescinds the authorization.
