

Enrolment of Non Supportable Adult Students

In recognition of the need of our local industries to attract workers Beautiful Plains will accept non supportable adults who wish to attend high school into the school division. The Division will waive the amount of school tuition that is raised through local taxation thus allowing adult workers to attend our high schools at a reduced tuition fee.

Adults that are not eligible for provincial education funding may be allowed to attend high school in Beautiful Plains School Division based on the following criteria:

- The payment of a tuition fee that shall equal the total funding of school programs (less categorical grants) provincial support plus Manitoba Property Tax Credits divided by the eligible FTE students enrolled in the Division. The tuition calculated above will be prorated based on the course load being taken. An additional fee will be charged if school bus transportation is provided.

- The student must possess the skills necessary to complete a regular high school program. The applicant's eligibility to enter high school in terms of their skill level will be determined by the school division.

This policy does not refer to students on Rotary exchange programs.
